Prof. Mircea Cîrnu was born on January 29, 1942 in the town Corabia, Olt County, Romania. In 1964 he graduated from Bucharest University with the Faculty of Mathematics and Mechanics and received his Ph. D. degree at the same University in 1976 under Acad. Prof. Romulus Cristescu's supervision. The title of his thesis is "The Representation of the Linear Continuous Operators". He was a scientific researcher at the Mathematical Institute of the Romanian Academy in Bucharest from 1964 to 1976 and afterwards from 1976 to 1978 at the Institute for Research and Design in Electrotechnics. He has been teaching Mathematics at the Polytechnic University of Bucharest, since 1978 and as a full professor since 1992.

Prof. Cîrnu published 60 research papers in Functional Analysis, Distribution Theory and Applied Mathematics. 16 books dedicated notably to didactical purposes and has presented 20 communications at several Scientific Sessions and Congresses. Among these, the Session of Distribution Theory and Partial Differential Equations, Oberwolfach, Germany (1972), the International Congress of Mathematicians, Helsinki, Finland (1978) and the First European Congress of Mathematics, Paris, France (1992) are notable. In 2013 he presented some communications at the Technical University of Istanbul, Turkey.

In his recent books "Algebraic Equations: New methods for old problems" and "Recurrence Equations. New topics and results", published by Lambert Publishing House, Saarbrücken, Germany, the results of the author on solving different types of equations, both classic and some new ones, introduced by himself, have been presented.

He is a Member of the American (1980) and Romanian (1964) Mathematical Societies and International Society for Analysis, its Applications and Computation (ISSAC) (2013). He is a reviewer to Zentralblatt für Mathematik (1970) and Mathematical Reviews (1972) and Member in the Editorial Boards of International Journal of Scientific and Innovative Mathematical Research (IJSIMR), International Journal of Mathematical Archive (IJMA) and Journal of Information Systems and Operations Managements (JISOM). He has reviewed many research papers for several journals like Revue Roumaine de Mathématique Pures et Appliquées, Mathematical Reports, Scientific Bulletin of the Polytechnic University of Bucharest, IJSIMR, IJMA, JISOM.

His short biography is published in Marquis Who's Who in the World. He is also included in Leading Educators of the World.
